

# Hamlyn Park plan revealed

GEELONG city council has developed a draft master plan for Hamlyn Park Recreation Reserve in Hamlyn Heights.

The draft plan envisages the development of a new oval, two netball courts, one of which can also be used for basketball, an indoor stadium and change facilities.

Geelong city councillors last night voted to release the draft plan for public comment, and residents have been invited to have their say.

The reserve is bordered by Western Heights College and the plan is part of the Vines Rd Redevelopment Project. Tenants include Bell Park Sport and Recreation Club, Hamlyn Park Tennis Club, Geelong Ballroom Dance Club and 1st Hamlyn Heights Scout Group.

The master plan includes the following recommendations as priority projects:

**IMPROVE** access to the tennis club rooms;

**IMPROVE** lighting at the reserve;

**REPLACE** cricket nets;

**DEVELOP** netball change facilities;

**UPGRADE** the Alex Rizun Pavilion; and

**GAIN** permanent access across disused rail line between the two facilities.
